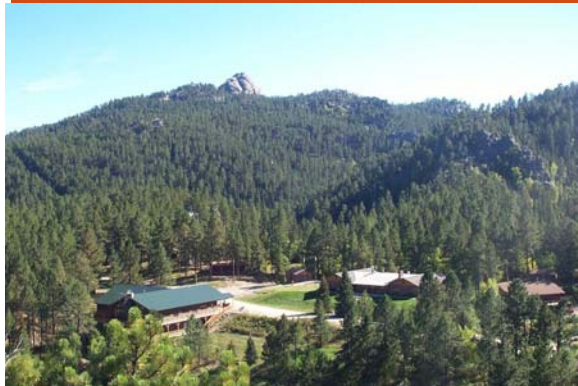

Rev. Dr. Reid S. Trulson, Exec. Director, IM ABC/USA

The Rev. Dr. Reid S. Trulson became the Executive Director of International Ministries in December, 2006. He graduated from the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis with a B.S. degree in History and from Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena, California with M.Div and D.Min degrees. From 1995 – 2000 Reid and his wife Janelle served as American Baptist missionaries to Europe, living in Austria and the Czech Republic. He then served for six years as Area Director, overseeing American Baptist missionaries and mission work in Europe and the Middle East, initiating and building partner relationships with 51 European and Middle Eastern Baptist Unions. Reid and Janelle have two daughters.
